# BAEA FLYING SUIT - 2016

## Order Form and Agreement



This suit specification has been chosen by BAeA and will be produced by Rig Equipment Ltd, which is based in Halesowen. Two materials are available:

**Kermel (fire retardant cotton): £268 and Proban (cotton): £233**

Both prices include VAT and one knee-board pocket, with white plastic sheet, (which has no piping).

The suits are navy blue with red highlights. Pockets on the chest and ankle, and the ankle and wrist openings are closed with zips. The side pockets allow access inside the suit. The upper-arm sleeve pockets are closed by Velcro flaps with pen divisions on the left arm, and room for a smart phone on the right. The aim has been to produce a suit that will be identifiable at airfields as a part of the BAeA image, be not too hot in summer - and be really functional! You need to confirm whether you want a left or right leg pocket but can order a second one if you want two. Lead time is 6-8 weeks for the suit make up. It will be posted direct to your address.



**Attached is a form for your measurements. Please read the guidelines and ensure someone is measuring you as it is impossible to measure yourself accurately. By filling in and returning the form, you take full responsibility for the measurements being accurate and therefore the sizing of the suit. Any alterations that may be necessary after the completion of the suit and that are found to have been caused by inaccurate measurement may be chargeable at the discretion of Rig Equipment Ltd.**

# RIG Equipment Ltd - MEASURING GUIDELINES for FLIGHT SUITS

These guidelines must be read in conjunction with the measurement diagram that accompanies this order form. The importance of following these guidelines carefully cannot be stressed enough. Your comfort depends on it.

**NEVER ATTEMPT TO MEASURE YOURSELF AS IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO MEASURE ACCURATELY.**

## GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Wear the garments you would generally wear under your flight suit.
  - Empty your pockets of any items such as mobile phones, wallets or bunches of keys.
  - Take accurate measurements in either centimetres or inches.
  - When measuring, you do not need to pull the tape tightly around the area you are measuring. Keep a light contact between the measuring tape and the area you are measuring. When measuring limbs, the tape should be free enough so that you may move it quite easily around the limb.
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- 1: CHEST:** The person being measured should lift their arms so they are horizontal with the shoulders. Pass the measuring tape around the body and hold it around the widest part of the chest/bust. Ask the person being measured to lower their arms over the tape. Make sure that the tape can easily be moved around the chest and take an accurate measurement.
  - 2: FLIGHT SUIT 'WAIST':** Standing up, choose a point level with the navel to take a measurement around the body. Make sure that the tape can easily be moved around the body and take an accurate measurement. ***DO NOT ASSUME THAT YOUR JEANS OR TROUSER WAIST SIZE IS CORRECT. PLEASE PHYSICALLY MEASURE YOUR WAIST AS INSTRUCTED – OFTEN FOREIGN MANUFACTURED GOODS ARE LARGER THAN STANDARD EUROPEAN SIZES.***
  - 3: HIPS:** Choose the area around the widest point of the buttocks. Make sure that the tape can easily be moved around the hips and take an accurate measurement.
  - 4: INSIDE LEG:** If trousers are being worn whilst the person is being measured, ask them to lift them up as close into the crotch as possible so they are close to the body. Take an accurate measurement from the point where the tops of the legs meet together in the middle down to the ankle bone.
  - 5: SLEEVE MEASUREMENT:** Ask the person being measured to lift their arm horizontally out to the side and then bend it at the elbow towards the chin. Whilst they hold the hand with the fingertips approximately 30cms (12") in front of the chin at shoulder level, take a measurement from where their neck meets their shoulders (usually where a t-shirt collar sits) along the outer edge of their arm, round the elbow to the wrist bone. It may help the measurer if the measurement is taken in two halves then added together; from the base of neck to elbow and from the elbow to the wrist bone.
  - 6: NAPE OF THE NECK TO SEAT:** This measurement gives the overall length of the body. First, sit upright on a hard chair or other surface where the person measuring has easy access to your back area. Take an accurate measurement from the base of the neck (where the neck meets the top of the shoulders) down along the backbone to the surface of the chair.
  - 7: HEIGHT:** Take an accurate height measurement standing at attention without shoes.
